



Valletta was built by the Knights of St. John after the Great Siege of Malta by the Ottomans in 1565. It is the fortified city that was said to be "Built by gentlemen for gentlemen". It boasts over 320 monuments in a .2 square mile radius, is a Baroque capital and is being recognized as the European Capital of Culture in 2018. You'll love what's in store within its main gates - a great mix of history and present day lively culture.

UPPER BARRAKKA GARDENS

A visit to Upper Barrakka Gardens promises a breathtaking panoramic experience. Perched on the edge of the Grand Harbour, it offers an unparalleled view of the Mediterranean's only natural harbor, framed by the historic Three Cities. Stroll through the greenery, enjoy tranquil moments by the fountains, and be captivated by the mesmerising sights.



ARCHAEOLOGY MUSEUM

Nestled within the historic capital of Valletta, the archaeology museum serves as a guardian of the island's prehistoric heritage. Here you will embark on a captivating journey through time, exploring artifacts from the UNESCO temples to those of the Phoenician and Roman periods. With the help of your guide, you will truly connect with the echoes of Malta's past.



INCLUDED LUNCH AT KING'S OWN BAND CLUB

Create lasting memories with casual dining in a historic setting at this restaurant within the King's Own Band Club, Valletta's oldest band club. Named after George, the Prince of Wales, who became King in 1937, the club holds living memories of British rule in Malta. Indulge your taste buds with a delightful Maltese delicacy lunch and local wine. As you dine, your guide will unravel the unique purposes and rivalries that characterize band clubs, providing a richer understanding of the cultural context.



MANOEL THEATRE

The Manoel Theatre is one of the oldest operating in Europe. Constructed in 1731 by the Grand Master Manoel de Vilhena, it was intended to be fit for the honest entertainment of the Knights of St John. With its intimate setting and rich acoustics, the theatre has hosted a myriad of performances, from plays and operas to contemporary productions.

ST JOHN'S CO-CATHEDRAL - PRIVATE VISIT

Built in the 16th century, this baroque jewel is more than just a place of worship; it is a visual symphony of art and architecture. The austere exterior of the cathedral gives way to a breathtaking interior adorned with ornate gilded embellishments, as well as Caravaggio's largest and only signed masterpiece -The Beheading of St John the Baptist.

Artefacts like the "Venus of Malta" bear witness to a rich prehistoric culture dating back over 5,000 years. In the south, we find a gem in Marsaxlokk which will be the focus of our lunch.


FALCONRY DISPLAY

Introducing Lawrence - the man who revived falconry in Malta. He fell in love with birds the first moment he cradled one given to him by his neighbour at the age of 4. Among his growing collection, he is a proud owner of the Maltese Peregrine Falcon. Enjoy the unique opportunity to hold it yourself, and observe the immense speed at which it can swoop for its prey.



HAGAR QIM & MNAJDRA TEMPLES

Hagar Qim and Mnajdra are UNESCO prehistoric temples thought to have been built to worship the fertility goddess. To put their age into perspective, they are around 1000 years older than the pyramids of Giza, and even Stonehenge. Through this visit, you will have the opportunity to say you visited the oldest, free-standing temples in the world!



BLUE GROTTO - PRIVATE BOAT EXPERIENCE

The Blue Grotto is a complex of sea caves that comprises a large and very impressive main arch, as well as a system of 6 other caves, among which you will find the Honeymoon Cave, the Cat's Cave and the beautiful Reflection Cave. This boat trip to the caves is the best way to experience the true beauty of the area and the stunning clear blue waters.



MARSAXLOKK VILLAGE

Marsaxlokk is celebrated as Malta's largest fishing port, and is dazzled with its fleet of luzzu boats. These iconic Maltese traditional vessels, adorned with vibrant colors and eye motifs on their bows, symbolise both fishermen's protection and good fortune. Immerse yourself in its maritime heritage and relish the unique charm of this coastal village.

FERRY TO GOZO

After taking a scenic drive towards the North of Malta, you'll enjoy a 25 minute crossing on board the Gozo Channel Ferry. Gozo is a more laid back island than Malta, full of sleepy villages, agricultural land and scenic hills. In fact, its nickname has long been "The Three Hills", representing the vantage points of the Cittadella, Xaghra and Nadur. Enjoy your time here as you discover the neat little gems and differences it has to offer from her sister island of Malta.



XWEJNI SALT PANS

Explore Gozo's ancient salt-making heritage with a visit to the Xwejni Salt Pans near Marsalforn. These traditional salt pans, a testament to centuries of sea salt production in Gozo, continue to be operational today. Learn about the fascinating process of salt harvesting while taking in the picturesque coastal scenery. It's a unique opportunity to connect with Gozo's rich history.



WIED IL-MIELAH WINDOW

Explore one of Malta natural wonders. The valley of Wied il-Mielaħ is rich in flora and a lovely place to walk especially in the autumn and spring. The way down the valley is like a botanical display of vegetation typical of the Mediterranean. Yellow rather than green is the primary colour here especially from late autumn until spring, when many fields bloom with the small yellow flower of the Cape Sorrel.




HANDS ON LUNCH EXPERIENCE


RUSTIC FARMER'S DINNER
